



The Rum List.

The rum list is broken down into 5 categories. Dark, White, Spiced, Rhum and Cachaca

Dark rum—Dark rum gets its colour from oak aging. The intense tropical heat expands and contracts the barrels and the wood becomes porous, like a sponge, forcing the spirit in and out of the oak. This adds all the flavours present in wood—sweetness, vanillin, tannins etc. Rum is often aged in bourbon and sherry barrels and this in turns brings additional flavours—a raisiny, syrupy sweetness in the case of sherry ageing, or toasty vanilla and smoke from bourbon barrel maturation

Rhum Agricole is the French term for cane juice rum, a style of rum originally distilled in the French West Indies islands from freshly squeezed sugar cane juice rather than molasses.

Cachaca is essentially a rum distilled from cachaca (fermented sugar cane juice—similar to that used to make Rhum Agricole). It is mainly produced in Brazil, where it is the country's most popular spirit, and it is bottles between 38% and 54% ABV
